



ALGONQUIN PARK - 7 DAY CANOE TRIP "Best of the Northwest"

Paddle west to east from North Tea Lake to Cedar Lake



Algonquin Park's northwest corner is famous for its wildlife, rolling hills, great fishing and beautiful lakes. Get deep into Algonquin's interior on this 7-day, 7-night day classic canoe trip and discover the best of the northwest section of Algonquin Park. Paddle a mix of large lakes and meandering rivers as we travel from Algonquin Park Access # 1 across the top of Algonquin to Cedar lake and the old town of Brent. Move at a relaxed pace through large lakes and slow moving stretches of river, with lots of time for wildlife viewing, hiking and backcountry exploration.

Sample Itinerary

Rendez-vous at Voyageur Quest Outfitting, located at Algonquin Park Access Point #1. Meet your guide and your group, and prepare for the adventure ahead. Slow down, decompress, enjoy a floating sauna, BBQ dinner and good night's sleep before departing at sunrise for 7 days of wilderness adventure.

Push off from Kawawaymog Lake, head down the Amable du Fond River, and into North Tea Lake to begin your journey. Spend the next week in the heart of Algonquin Park's northwestern backcountry. Learn to paddle, portage, and reconnect with the beauty of the park. Enjoy paddling the deep lakes, swimming in the clear, fresh water, and sleeping under the stars at spectacular wilderness campsites. Feast on delicious backcountry cuisine. Keep your eyes open for moose, great blue heron, loon, and beaver.

Finish up the adventure at Cedar Lake and the Old Town of Brent and shuttle back to Voyageur Quest for a farewell lunch.

The above itinerary is an example - the exact program is tailored your guide to the preferences of the group and weather conditions.

The package includes: 6 nights camping accommodation and 1 night cabin accommodation, all meals, all equipment, park permits, canoeing, hiking, and wildlife interpretation, and the services of a wilderness guide.



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HOW MUCH EXPERIENCE DO YOU NEED?

Participants should be comfortable backcountry camping, although no previous canoe experience is required. Our pace is relaxed - the objective is to have fun, slow down, and leave plenty of time to explore the beauty of the Park. As long as you can be active for up to 4 hours a day and have a hunger to learn, you will enjoy yourself. Come by yourself or bring a friend. These canoe trips feature a small group size.



CAMPING IN ALGONQUIN PARK

Practice "no-trace camping" as you paddle into Algonquin Park. Campsites are selected for their location and scenic views overlooking the water. Tents (2, 3 and 4-person) are organized according to your group size. Add extra comfort with a sleeping bag and air mattress rental. Feast on gourmet backcountry meals incorporating fresh, local ingredients. Dietary requirements? No problem. Let us know and we'll take care of the details.
